Fellowship as hospitality is one of the cornerstones of our faith. Thank you for volunteering to share your gifts with all.

Specific Tasks:

- You may bring whatever you wish for fellowship, there are no special requirements. A good guide is; something sweet, something salty, and some fruit.
- If coffee is not prepared when you arrive, please make 40 cups. ½ cup of coffee will yield 10 cups of coffee. (2 cups of coffee for 40 servings.)
- Set up coffee area with cups, sugar, creamer and utensils. The coffee is usually made for the 8:30 service. There is a supply of pretzels that may be used between services if desired.
- Before church, put out a pitcher of ice water and cups. Prepare some juice and keep it in the fridge until after the service.
- During the last hymn is usually a good time to slip out in order to place your refreshments on the table. Plates and napkins may be found in the metal cabinet in the kitchen.
- Refill juice as needed during fellowship hour. Afterwards, wash the coffee pot, clean up. Clean up consists of making sure the kitchen area is clean, dishes washed, and all trash in the church is taken to the dumpster. Liners are under the kitchen sink. Please bring the dumpster around and place in the handicap parking area in front of the church for Monday morning pickup.
