

Helps Ministry-Greeting

God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healing, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.
I Corinthians 12:28

We are very good at welcoming people at Blue Ridge. In addition to saying “Good Morning” to each other, greeters are the first to welcome visitors. As a greeter, you are the face of Blue Ridge, and first time visitors are “observing us,” if they have a good experience, they will return.

Specific Tasks:

- Arrive at least 20 minutes before the service. You’ll find a greeter sticker on the table by the front door.
- Welcome visitors with a warm smile, a firm handshake, a kind word. (For visitors, you are the first impression of our church and an extension of the Pastor)
- Hand out a bulletin, **For visitors:** ask if they need childcare arrangements, explain about children’s church, let them know about the books in the corner. Tell them where the restrooms are, and invite them to fellowship. Give them a brochure, or point out materials they may want to take.
- If the sanctuary looks full, see that an usher helps visitors find a seat.
- Remain in the narthex until the congregation begins the first hymn.
- Afterwards, ask visitors if they have any questions, introduce them to the Pastor or other members of the Evangelism Team. Offer to get some coffee or juice. Thank them for visiting us!
